Precautions to take during use

- Do not sit too close to the screen. Sit a good distance away from the monitor, as far away as the keyboard and mouse cables allow.
- Avoid using the software if you are tired or have not had much sleep.
- Make sure that the room in which you are using the software is well lit.
- Rest for at least 10 to 15 minutes in every hour you are using the software.

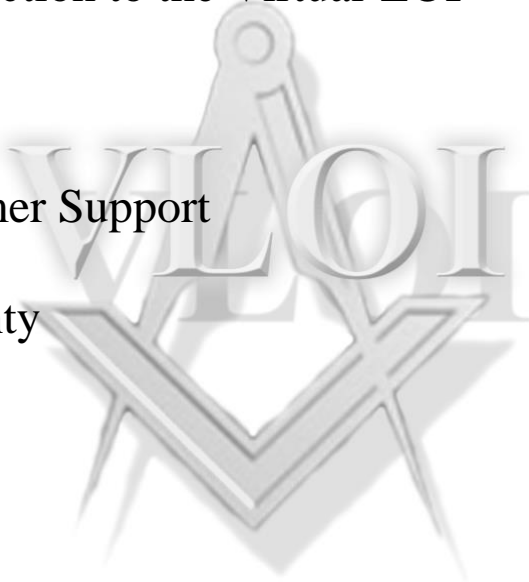

Installation and Licensing

A word on authorisation, licences
and software piracy.

Warning –

To reassure various Masonic authorities that this software will not fall into the wrong hands and in the interest of stopping un-authorised users from obtaining or using this software, we have put various security measures in place. These security measures include controlling the distribution of the software. If a user copies this software or passes it to another person they have broken their software licence agreement. If an unauthorised person contacts us to try to obtain a key code we will know that an illegal copy has been made.

The software licence agreement only authorises you to use your Virtual-LOI software on ONE computer. If for instance you envisage using the software on a laptop while on holiday then you must install it on the laptop from the start, as your key code will not work on a different machine.

To obtain more than one key code means that the software is being run on more than one machine and therefore a further licence for the software should be purchased. It is **very strongly** advised that you install the Virtual-LOI software on the **ONE** machine you intend to use it on.

The install and running of the Virtual-LOI can be completed in 4 steps:

- 1- Installing the QuickTime player (if you already have QuickTime on your computer you can skip this step)
- 2 - Installing the Virtual-LOI
- 3 - Licensing the Virtual-LOI
- 4 - Setting up your personal password

1 - Installing the QuickTime Player

Before installing your Virtual-LOI product you **MUST** have the Apple QuickTime player installed on your PC. If you do not already have QuickTime installed, you can download it free of charge from the Apple website (www.apple.com)

The following steps will guide you through the download process, should Apple change their website after this user guide has gone to print, we will include an updated instruction sheet to guide you through the procedure.

DOWNLOADING QUICKTIME

- Open your web browser and go to <https://support.apple.com/downloads/quicktime>
- It should show **Results for "QuickTime"**
- Select **Download QuickTime 7.7.9 for Windows** and click 'download'
- A 'file download' window will appear. Select 'Save' and click OK. The executable file will download to your PC.
- A 'Save as' window might also appear to ask where you want the file to be saved. Select the location for the file to be downloaded to and click 'Save' to confirm.

INSTALLING QUICKTIME

- Go to the location on your computer where you saved the executable file and double click on the 'QuickTimeInstaller.exe' icon.
- Select the language and click OK.
- Follow the onscreen instructions to install the QuickTime player.
- QuickTime will now install.

2 - Installing the Virtual-LOI on your PC

Note: To unlock your software you will need the Lock code generated at the end of the installation process as follows.

1. *Insert one of the CDs into the CD-ROM drive.*
2. *Double-click on 'My Computer' on the desktop*
3. *Double-click on the CD-ROM icon*
“VLOICRAFT(D:)”
(Where D: is your CD-ROM drive letter).
4. *Double-click on the “VLOICRAFT .msi” file to begin the install program.*
5. *Follow the onscreen instructions*

Once your software has been installed you should find two new icons on your desktop, one “Virtual-LOI” icon and one “Licenser” icon.

1. *Select the “Licenser” icon from the desktop*
2. *Write down the ‘Lock Code’ displayed in the licenser window(Or copy it to a text file).*
3. *Direct your browser to: <http://virtual-loi.co.uk/key-code-request/> , fill out the required information and submit.*
4. *We currently process key code requests on the on **Monday and Thursday evenings** so you will receive your key code by midnight on the **next respective day**.*

3 - Licensing the software

Once you have obtained your key-code, either by email (preferred method) or by telephone, you can license your software by doing the following:

1. Click on the “Licenser” icon on the desktop
2. Click on the “Enter Key code” button on the licenser
3. Enter your Key code into the box in the Licenser window then click ‘OK’.

Your Licenser window should now display

“This installation of ‘VLOI Craft’ is licensed”

WARNING – The key-code will only work on the PC that the software was first installed on. When you receive your key-code, write it down in the space provided so that you do not lose it. If you need to re-install the software you will need to enter the key-code again.

4 - Setting up your personal password

1. Ensure that one of the Virtual-LOI CDs is in the CD drive
2. Click on the Virtual-LOI icon on the desktop
3. Watch the introduction. This is a good time to set the volume (Click anywhere to skip the intro)
4. Click on 'Start'
5. Click on 'Change'
6. Ensure that the 'Enter old' box is empty
7. Enter a password of your choice into the 'Enter new' box
8. Enter the same password into 'Re-enter new'
9. Click on the 'Go' button. You are now presented with the main menu screen where you will select the officer you wish to practice.
10. Click on the officer you wish to practice from the highlighted shields (e.g. WM). After a short delay a red box will appear around the shield you selected.
11. Select the section of the ritual you wish to practice. After a short delay the main user screen will appear and the software is fully operational.

Running once the above has been completed

1. Click on the Virtual-LOI icon on the desktop
2. Enter your personal password
3. Click 'Go'
4. Select the section you wish to practice

Please Note: Our test team assure us that it is a HUGE help to understand the functions of the user screen BEFORE using the software. We therefore STRONGLY recommend that users spend some time going through the ‘Help’ pages before using the software

Introduction to the Virtual-LOI software

Each of the Virtual-LOI product range comprises a set of three CD's, each containing the data for one of the craft rituals.

The CDs contained in this package contains the Virtual-LOI software and the specific data for the office indicated on the CD and packaging. For the purposes of this description this will be referred to as 'Your Officer'.

The prompts supplied are those associated with your officer and the video is filmed specifically to show the movements and actions of your officer. Where there is movement around the lodge the video shows that movement. Where there is dialogue with another officer the view is usually face to face with the other officer, some times simply facing him (Known as 'first person view'), and sometimes filmed as if the camera is looking over your officers' shoulder (This is known as 'third person view'). Occasionally the camera will show a more general view where appropriate.

All of the Virtual Lodge of Instruction products have been built using the 'Virtual Learning Engine' (VLE) software. The VLE is a generic software platform, developed by VLOI, on which many similar virtual learning tools can be built.

Using the Virtual-LOI

Familiarise yourself with the user screen

Familiarise yourself with the user screen for a while, referring back to the help pages where necessary.

Learn to navigate the video

Next, learn to navigate forwards and backwards through the ritual by first playing the video using the blue 'play' button in the lower right area of the screen, then using the 'Next' and 'Previous' 'Speech' buttons in the lower right area of the screen. These buttons allow you to jump to your next or previous speech in the movie. Use the prompt 'phrase' button to check where you are in the dialogue.

Play the video

When it is your officers' turn to speak, the video will stop and a flashing prompt will appear telling you to "Practice your words, ask for a prompt or press 'play' to continue playing the video".

Learn to request a prompt

If you require a prompt at this point, you can get one by selecting one of the audio prompt buttons on the upper right side of the screen. Click 'play' button in either the sentence or phrase area and you will hear the appropriate prompt. You can then practice your words then press the video 'play' button to continue with the ritual.


You should now be able to find your way around the Virtual Lodge of Instruction without any problems. We wish you every success in learning your ritual and sincerely hope that this software enables you to truly make a **“daily advancement in Masonic knowledge”**.
